RESOLUTION GRANTING THE REQUEST OF HIGHWAY CARRIERS ASSOCIATION
FOR CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO ENGAGE IN COLLECTIVE RATEMAKING
AGREEMENTS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 496 OF THE PUBLIC
UTILITIES CODE

On April 10, 1979, the Commission issued Decision 90171 author-
izing Highway Carriers Association, 6279 E. Slauson Avenue, Suite
101, City of Commerce, CA 90040, to enter into collective rate-
making agreements with motor common carriers pursuant to Section
496 of the Public Utilities Code.

In a letter dated June 29, 1987, Chris Bowman, President of
Highway Carriers Association (HCA), requested the Commission to
rescind HCA's authority to engage in collective ratemaking under
agreements approved pursuant to Section 496 of the Public Util-
ities Code.

IT IS ORDERED that: Highway Carriers Association cease collective
ratemaking activities and that collective ratemaking agreements
authorized under Decision 90171 pursuant to Public Utilities
Code Section 496 are cancelled.

The Executive Director shall cause service of a copy of this res-
olution on Highway Carriers Association at their address of re-
cord on file with the Commission.

This resolution is effective today.
