RESOLUTION NO. W-3466 September 7, 1989

RESOLUTION

(RES. W-3466), HILLVIEW WATER COMPANY, INC. (HWC). ORDER AUTHORIZING AN OFFSET RATE INCREASE PRODUCING \$23,400 OR 7.6% ADDITIONAL ANNUAL REVENUE.

By Advice Letter No. 31, filed April 21, 1989, HWC requests authority under Section VI of General Order 96-A, and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Odde to increase rates to offset! (1) a \$20,530 increase in water testing costs, and (2) a \$2,870 increase due to an undercollection in the purchased power balancing account. HWC serves about 800 metered customers in seven communities in and around Oakhurst, Madera County.

The present rates became effective on June 3, 1987 pursuant to Decision 87-01-055 which established a new Safe Drinking Water Bond Act (SDWBA) surcharge. The latest Commission decision relating to a general rate increase is Decision 82-08-83, in which the Commission found a rate of return on rate base of 11.75% reasonable for 1982. The requested increase would not result in a rate of return greater than last authorized for HWC.

Since the increase caused by changes in undercollection in purchased power balancing account is related to water consumption, it is applied to the quantity blocks. The increase caused by changes in the cost of water testing, which is fixed and not related to water consumption, is applied to the service charge.

HWC has given public notice of the request for increase by publishing in the local newspaper on July 13, 1989. No customer protests or correspondence have been received.

HWC's wells are in good condition and there is an adequate water supply. No additional conservation measures are needed.

Service is satisfactory. There are no Commission orders requiring system improvement, nor are there significant service problems requiring corrective action.

After investigation by the Water Utilities Branch, the Commission finds that the requested rate increase hereby authorized is justified, and that the resulting rates are reasonable. HWC is directed to maintain its balancing accounts as required by Public Utilities Code Section 792.5.

THE COMMISSION FINDS that the increased rates hereby authorized are justified and that the present are for the future, unjust and unreasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that Hillview Water Company is authorized, on the effective date herein, to make effective revised Schedule Nos. 1, 4, and 9N attached to Advice Letter No. 31 and to cancel the presently effective rate schedule for water service.

This resolution is effective today.
