## RESOLUTION

(RES. W-3491), CALITOPNLA KATER SERVICE OCAIPANY (CWS), DIXOH DISTRICT. ORDER AUTHORIZTIG AU OFFSET RATE IHCREASE FROOUCTHG $\$ 37,600$ OR 5, 7\% ADDITIOTAL, ARMUAL REVEMUE.

By Advice Letter (A. L.) 1126, filed Manch 16, 1990, Chs nequests authority under section VI of General Onder 96-A, and section 454 of the Public utilities code to increase rates to offset: (1) a $\$ 10,500$ increase in purchased power oosts, (2) a $\$ 600$ increase in district ad valoren taxes, (3) a $\$ 26,500$ increase due to an underoollection in the water production balancing aoocunt. Chis serves about 2,628 metered oustaners in Dixon and vicinity, Solano County.

The present rates became effective on January 1, 1990 pursuant to Decision Ho. 89-04-005 in which the Cammission found the rates of return on rate base of $11.33 \%$ for 1989 , 11.33 for 1990 , and $11.33 \%$ for 1991 reasonable, with a $12.25 \%$ return on equity. This offset increase will not result in a rate of netum greater than last authorized.

Since the increase is caused primarily by changes in the cost of purchased power which is directly related to water consmption, it is applied to the puantity blocks for metered custoners. Rates for the first three Ocf will be increased by $\$ .017$ per Gcf (One Ocf is equal to one-hundred cubic-feet) while rates for over thnee cof will be increased by $\$ 0.015$ per Ocf.

In addition, the Branch recommends, in aooordance with the Camission's balancing acoount policy for water utilities, that the underoollection in the water production balancing aocount be amortized over a 24 -month period by adding a surchange of $\$ 0.0365$ per Ocf.

The water Utllities Branch has reviened the latest pump efficiency tests and found ther satisfactory.

CWS has a variety of programs designed to promote water oonservation including monthly reminders in water bills, leak detection service, free custamer oonservation parphlets, free water oonservation kits and a variety of conservation literature for presentation to schools and public information meetings.

Service is satisfactory. There are no Cormission orders requiring system improvement, nor are there significant service problems requiring corrective action.

Chs has given public notice of the request for increase by publishing in the local newspaper on Manch 23, 1990. Ho custoner protests or correspondence have been reocived.
