RESOLUTION

(RES. W-3692), NISH WATER SYSTEM (NWS). ORDER
AUTHORIZING A ONE-TIME SURCHARGE PRODUCING ADDITIONAL
ANNUAL REVENUE OF \$1,100 OR 1.57% FOR 1992.

BACKGROUND

By Advice Letter 22, filed September 11, 1992, NWS requested authority under Section VI of General Order 96-A and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to impose a one-time charge of \$2.54 per customer to recover the Department of Health Services (DHS) fee for fiscal year July 1, 1991 to June 30, 1992. NWS serves 429 flat rate and 4 metered rate customers in an area known as Fairview Park, Tract 260 and vicinity, 1 mile north of Visalia in Tulare County.

The present rates became effective on July 15, 1992, pursuant to Resolution W-3657 which authorized a general rate increase of \$15,954 or 25.57%.

DISCUSSION

Resolution W-3641 dated May 8, 1992 authorized each water utility regulated by the Commission and subject to the provisions of Health and Safety Code Sections 4020 and 4020.5 to establish a memorandum account in which to record payment of Department of Health Services Office of Drinking Water fees resulting from those code sections. Subject utilities were also authorized to request recovery of the account balance by advice letter filing in accordance with General Order No. 96-A.

Pursuant to W-3657, NWS is authorized to file for an offset rate increase to recover the DHS annual fee once the official bill has been received.

The surcharge requested herein would allow NWS to recover the memorandum account balance established to record DHS fees for fiscal year July 1, 1991 - June 30, 1992.

PROTESTS

NWS mailed a notice of this increase request to all customers on September 10, 1992. No protests have been received.

Service is satisfactory. There are no Commission orders requiring system improvement, nor are there service problems requiring corrective action.

The Branch recommends that NWS be authorized to assess a one-time surcharge of \$2.54 to each single-family residential unit to recover the \$1,100 balance in the memorandum account accruing the billed DHS fee. Revenues received from

such surcharge should be limited to the initial amount billed to NWS by DHS. The Branch further recommends that NWS be authorized to hold open such memorandum account until NWS' next general rate proceeding.


FINDINGS

THE COMMISSION FINDS, after investigation by the Branch, that recovery of the memorandum account balance authorized herein is justified, and the resulting one-time charge of \$2.54 is just and reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Nish Water System is authorized, on the effective date herein, to make effective revised Schedule No. 1, General Metered Service, and Schedule No. 2R, Residential Flat Rate Service, attached to Advice Letter No. 22 and to cancel the presently effective Schedules No. 1 and 2R.
2. The memorandum account as authorized above may remain open until Nish Water System's next general rate proceeding.
3. This resolution is effective today.
