RESOLUTION

(RES. W-3719), SAN GABRIEL VALLEY WATER COMPANY, FONTANA DIVISION (SGVWC). ORDER AUTHORIZING A ONE-TIME SURCHARGE PRODUCING ADDITIONAL ANNUAL REVENUE OF \$15,450 OR 0.1% FOR FISCAL YEAR 1991-1992.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 268-A SUPPLEMENT, FILED NOVEMBER 13, 1992.

BACKGROUND

SGVWC requested authority under Section VI of General Order 96-A and Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to impose a one-time charge of \$0.52 per customer to recover the Department of Health Services (DHS) fee for fiscal year July 1, 1991 through June 30, 1992. SGVWC presently serves 29,659 metered rate customers near portions of Fontana, Rancho Cucamonga, Rialto, and vicinity, San Bernardino County.

The present rates became effective on April 13, 1992, pursuant to Decision No. 92-04-032, which authorized a \$857,400 or 5.84% increase for 1993.

DISCUSSION

Resolution W-3641, dated May 8, 1992, authorized each water utility regulated by the Commission and subject to the provisions of Health and Safety Code Sections 4020 and 4020.5 to establish a memorandum account in which to record payment of Department of Health Services Office of Drinking Water fees resulting from those code sections. Subject utilities were also authorized to request recovery of the account balance by advice letter filing in accordance with General Order No. 96-A.

The surcharge requested herein would allow SGVWC to recover the memorandum account balance established on the basis of receipt of the DHS bill for fiscal year July 1, 1991 through June 30, 1992. The DHS fee would be paid from the funds collected from SGVWC's customers as provided in W-3641.

The Water Utilities Branch (Branch) recommends that SGVWC be authorized to assess a one-time surcharge of \$0.52 to each metered customer to recover the \$15,450 balance in the memorandum account accruing the billed DHS fee. Revenue received from such surcharge should be limited to the initial amount billed to SGVWC by DHS. The Branch further recommends that SGVWC be authorized to hold open such memorandum account until SGVWC next general rate proceeding.

Service is satisfactory. There are no Commission orders requiring system improvement, nor are there service problems requiring corrective action.

PROTESTS

SGVWC published a notice of this increase request in a local paper on September 16, 1992. No protests have been received.


FINDINGS

THE COMMISSION FINDS, after investigation by the Branch, that recovery of the memorandum account balance authorized herein is justified, and the resulting one-time charge of \$0.52 is just and reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. San Gabriel Valley Water Company is authorized, five days after the effective date herein, to make effective revised Schedule No. FO-1 (continued), General Metered Service, attached to this resolution as Appendix A, and to cancel the presently effective Schedule No. FO-1 (continued).
2. The memorandum account as authorized above may remain open until San Gabriel Valley Water Company's next general rate proceeding.
3. This resolution is effective today.

GENERAL METERED SERVICE

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. A surcharge of \$0.020 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rates for a 36-month period after October 12, 1990, to amortize a portion of the undercollection in the purchased water balancing account.
2. A surcharge of \$0.097 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rates for a 24-month period from the effective date of this tariff schedule to amortize an undercollection in the purchased water balancing account due to Chino Basin Watermaster's assessment for water production during 1989-1990 and 1990-1991.
3. A surcharge of \$0.015 per Ccf is to be added to the quantity rates for a 12-month period from the effective date of Advice Letter No. 265 to amortize the Drought Memorandum Account.
4. As authorized by the California Public Utilities Commission, all bills are subject to a one-time surcharge of \$0.52. This charge offsets the Department of Health Services fee as billed to San Gabriel Valley Water Company for fiscal year July 1, 1991 to June 30, 1992.
5. All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth in Schedule No. AA-UF.

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
