Getting to the Conference

San Francisco Airport (SFO) is the most convenient and accessible to the conference. However, if you cannot find a reasonably priced fare to SFO, you might also try the Oakland Airport (OAK). For some locations and cities, more flights are available to OAK than SFO and Southwest Airlines has extensive operations in Oakland. Once you arrive in either Oakland or San Francisco, you can take the Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) to arrive near your hotel. BART goes directly to SFO (look for signs) and costs \$8.25 to go to downtown San Francisco. The nearest stops to the hotel are either the Montgomery or Embarcadero Station. The hotel is 10 to 15 blocks from the Embarcadero Station, or a short cab ride away. Cabs from San Francisco Airport could run \$35-45 and would be significantly higher from Oakland Airport.

From the Oakland Airport you need to take a bus shuttle (known as AirBart) to the Oakland Coliseum BART station which is \$3.00 cash only. Bart Fare from the Oakland Coliseum to the Embarcadero or Montgomery Station is \$3.85 one-way.
