

BIOGRAPHY OF JANICE BEECHER

Prof. Janice Beecher has served as Director of the Institute of Public Utilities at Michigan State University since 2002. Her areas of interest include regulatory theory, institutions, principles, and ethics; market failure and response; structural and regulatory change; commission jurisdiction, organization, and demographics; and ratemaking and incentives. She is a frequent author, lecturer, and participant in national and international academic and professional forums and is Associate Editor of *Utilities Policy*. She previously held positions at The Ohio State and Indiana Universities and the Illinois Commerce Commission. Prof. Beecher has appointments at MSU in Political Science and Economics, teaches courses in public policy and regulation, and supervises graduate research students. She holds a B.A. in Economics, Political Science, and history from Elmhurst College and a M.A. and Ph.D. in Political Science from Northwestern University.
