**NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION**

Pursuant to Rule 8.3(a) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby gives notice of the following *ex parte* communication. The communication occurred on Monday, January 11, 2010, at approximately 10:00 a.m. at the offices of the California Public Utilities Commission in San Francisco. The communication was oral and included a handout, which is attached. [Rule 8.3(a) (1)]

Sidney Dietz, Director, Regulatory Relations, PG&E, initiated the communication with Andrew Campbell, Commission Advisor. Also present from were: Dina Mackin, Regulatory Analyst, and Elaine Chan Lau, Regulatory Analyst, both of CPUC-Energy Division; John Warnock, Director, and Christopher Vana, Program Director, both of PG&E-ISTS. [Rule 8.3(a) (2)]

Mr. Dietz stated that PG&E now agrees that the upgrade of the Customer Care and Billing system (CC&B) directly to version 2.3. is the most efficient approach. Mr. Warnock stated that version 2.3 is now available and ready from the supplier. Mr. Dietz stated that the inclusion of a reservation option in the A10 rate would cause problems for the rate, and could not be programmed in time for summer. Mr. Warnock stated that customer alerts triggered by bill

amounts would require CC&B to calculate every customer bill every day, and is beyond the system's capabilities. [Rule 8.3(a) (3)]
