Sorry for the delay in replying to your questions.

The OEEP software is based on the paper that I wrote and presented in a conference. I think the paper has been referenced in the PTM and also Commissioner John Bohn referenced it in the October 26<sup>th</sup> Commission meeting. Based on that, I feel that it will be very difficult for others to get the patent on this subject.

My recommendation to SCE was to develop the basic model algorithm and provide the algorithm (based on the differential equations) to the regulated water utilities to write the computer software language of their choice, which depends on the "Programmable Logic Controller" and "Variable Speed Drive" manufacturer. This actual computer software program will owned by the water utility and can be purchased by others, if they have same PLC & VSD hardware.

To the best my memory this was discussed with David Jacot and Don Arambula in one of the meetings at SCE office. Until now we have not been able to do it, with your help we may be able to achieve it.

The second choice is for each Water Utility to contract to a different system engineering consultant to write language, so that it can be repeated multiple times.

As this is **Research Development & Demonstration projects**, the choice belongs to electric IOU'S.
