Per our meeting discussion yesterday,
here is a proposed change to Step 4 on P. 4. I have include
both the original text and the proposed edits for clarity:

Current:

These values are intended to capture
the approximate 10-20% largest projects that may represent 50-70% of the
total custom measure ex ante savings. This submission will be an online
submission to Energy Division and will be done at the time of utility application
approval.

Revised:

These values are intended to capture approximately 10-20% of the largest projects where the majority of the project savings are custom measures. These projects may represent 50-70% of the total custom measure ex ante savings. This submission will be an on-line submission to Energy Division and will be initiated as previously indicated.

Note that we still have concerns about the wording for both the trigger levels and the grouping of multiple measures for the trigger level, but these can be addressed separately.
