Attached you will find a photo of Governor Jerry Brown's visit to The Geysers c.1977. As I recall, first oil embargo was behind us, and the second oil embargo was about to happen.

Gov. Jerry and his entourage, which included two CA State Agency Directors, flew to Lakeport and toured the steam field. This photo was taken on the site of PG&E Unit 17 which was a very controversial site at the time. Mary Jadiker, in the foreground, was a Lake County Planning Commissioner and owner of the Binkley Ranch adjacent to Calpine's L'Esperance lease and near Unit 17. Also pictured behind, and to the right of Mary, was Donald Johnson, Lake County Planning Director.
