year. In addition, 2,900 businesses became more energy efficient through improvements like replacing steam traps for dry cleaners, also reducing carbon dioxide emissions.

During 2008 alone, our customers reduced demand by 459 megawatts and saved 2,844 gigawatt-hours and 39.3 million therms. The company also distributed more than \$198 million in rebates to our customers for the year.
