## QUESTION 3P

PG&E forecasted \$40.712 million for MWC BF. This is an increase of \$7.487 million or 22.53% over 2008 recorded adjusted expenses of \$33.225 million. PG&E's MWC BF includes individual forecasts for ten subaccounts/line items. The questions below relate to the following five subaccounts/line items and forecast: \$5.641 million for Overhead Line Equipment Inspected and Tested, \$1.131 million for Underground Line Equipment Inspected, \$0.311 million for Special Patrols, and \$0.881 million for Miscellaneous Maintenance Items.

p) Provide the number of special patrols performed and the unit cost for 2009.

## ANSWER 3P

PG&E objects to this question on the grounds that the question asks for actual 2009 data, which is not the basis of PG&E's 2011 GRC request. Notwithstanding the foregoing, and without waiving PG&E's right to object to the admissibility of the requested information into evidence, PG&E responds as follows.

The preliminary 2009 recorded units and unit cost data for special patrols are as follows: 14,576 units and \$36.50, respectively.
