Re: PG&E's Comments on Draft Resolution E-4326

Dear Mr. Gatchalian:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") submits the following comments on Draft Resolution E-4326 ("Draft Resolution"), which was issued on April 5, 2010, in advance of the Commission's consideration and potential vote on May 6, 2010.

The Draft Resolution approves with modifications PG&E's Advice Letter 3544-E, which request Commission approval a renewable power purchase agreement ("PPA") with Geysers Power Company, LLC ("Geysers") for purchase of incremental Renewables Portfolio Standard ("RPS") eligible energy from Geysers' 725 megawatt ("MW") geothermal generation system in Sonoma and Lakes Counties, California. The Draft Resolution requires PG&E to submit a Tier 1 advice letter within 30 days after the effective date of the Resolution containing a modified power purchase agreement executed by the buyer and seller that includes all of the non-modifiable required standard terms and conditions required pursuant to D.10-03-021.

The Draft Resolution summarizes the annual deliveries under the agreement in the following table:

Deliveries in the first 2 periods, 2010–2012 and 2013–2014, include deliveries under two existing PPAs that PG&E previously executed with Geysers. One of the two existing PPAs will terminate upon approval of the new PPA and the deliveries under the previous PPA, approved by the Commission in Resolution E-4046, will continue under the terms and conditions of the new PPA. The other existing PPA, approved by the Commission in Resolution E-4164, will continue as a separate PPA and is not affected by the new PPA. Deliveries under the continuing PPA, 1,456 GWh per year, are therefore not part of the new PPA that PG&E is seeking the Commission's approval for in Advice Letter 3544-E. The Draft Resolution should be modified to summarize deliveries under the under the new agreement to exclude the deliveries of the continuing PPA. The corrected deliveries are summarized in the table below:
