I'm looping back to you on this letter, but limiting the distribution to the "core" CCA team here at CPUC. Could you let us know how & when you plan to respond to this letter from MEA? (I realize you will need to send your response to the larger list or whatever PG&E sees as necessary—I'm just looking into the particular issues listed here). I'm particularly concerned that the PG&E reps seem to have a pattern of making up random-but-harmful-to-MEA answers to questions that "stump" them, such as (in this letter) how a customer can opt-back-in to MEA service. I can cite several earlier examples, so this is worrisome to me.

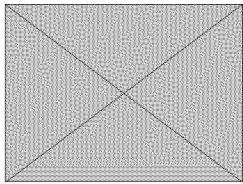
