**SUBJECT: LEAK SURVEY**

**QUESTION 2**

Please provide the number of leaks detected for 2010 YTD and the number of miles leak surveyed as part of GEEM and without GEEM.

**ANSWER 2**

PG&E objects to this question on the grounds that it asks for actual 2010 data, while PG&E's 2011 GRC request is based on 2008 recorded data. Notwithstanding the foregoing, and without waiving PG&E's right to object to the admissibility of the requested information into evidence, PG&E responds as follows:

Through the end of March 2010 PG&E has detected 12,395 leaks on the distribution system year-to-date while surveying a total of 6,100 miles of gas distribution facilities. Of these 6,100 miles of gas distribution facilities leak surveyed 3,922 were surveyed through the GEEM leak survey program and 2,177 were surveyed through the routine leak survey program (without GEEM).
