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I. SUMMARY OF RELIEF REQUESTED

Pursuant to Rule 11.4 of this Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Law and Motion Resolution ALJ-164, Decision 06-06-066, Public Utilities Code Section 583 ("Section 583"), and General Order ("GO") 66-C, Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") files this motion for leave to file confidential information under seal. The material PG&E seeks to protect is included in the confidential, unredacted version of Joint Petition of Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Russell City Energy Company, LLC, Division of Ratepayers Advocates, California Unions For Reliable Energy, and The Utility Reform Network for Modification of Decision 09-04-010, as Modified by Decision 10-02-033 ("Joint Petition") in the above-captioned proceeding.

II. THE MATERIALS PG&E SEEKS TO FILE UNDER SEAL ARE PROTECTED UNDER CONFIDENTIALITY RULES THE COMMISSION ESTABLISHED IN DECISION 06-06-066, PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE SECTION 583, GO 66-C

In Decision 06-06-066, the Commission adopted rules and procedures governing the submission of confidential electric procurement information to the Commission. In a Matrix, attached to the Decision, the Commission established specific rules for Investor-Owned Utilities

("IOUs") governing certain categories of data and information. Decision 08-04-023 requires that material formally filed with the Commission for which an IOU seeks confidential treatment must be accompanied by a Motion. In its Motion the IOU must establish:

- 1) that the material it is submitting constitutes a particular type of data listed in the Matrix;
- 2) which category or categories in the Matrix the data correspond to;
- 3) that it is complying with the limitations on confidentiality specified in the Matrix for that type of data;
- 4) that the information is not already public; and
- 5) that the data cannot be aggregated, redacted, summarized, masked or otherwise protected in a way that allows partial disclosure. 1/2

In addition, Section 583 provides that, "[n]o information furnished to the commission by a public utility. . . except those matters specifically required to be open to public inspection by this part, shall be open to public inspection or made public except on order of the commission, or by the commission or commissioner in the course of a hearing or proceeding."

Finally, Paragraph 2.8 of GO 66-C provides that public records not open to public inspection include "[i]nformation obtained in confidence from other than a business regulated by this Commission where the disclosure would be against the public interest."
