Our 2011 estimated generation charges assume a 6% decrease in our generation rates, which is our current projection but is subject to change. For 2012, we have increased the generation rates by 3.4%, which is a conservative estimate as discussed in our January 4, 2011 letter to Mr. Charles McGlashan, Chairman of the Marin Energy Authority.
