QUESTION 8H

PG&E forecasted \$1.432 million for Miscellaneous Maintenance Items in 2011 which is an increase of \$0.954 million or 199.58% over 2008 expenses of \$0.478 million.

- h) Provide the documentation that explains in detail why PG&E did not reallocate/move a portion of its historical expenses/funding from its Engineering and Standards Department's standard rate where equipment failure analysis expenses were recorded and move it to MWC BG since this is where the work will now be recorded.

ANSWER 8H

Documentation that explains in detail why PG&E did not reallocate/move a portion of its historical charges from the Engineering Department's standard rate to MWC BG is not available. At the time PG&E prepared the 2011 forecast, the volume and associated costs to perform failure analysis were assumed to be limited and insignificant.

In 2008 approximately \$80 thousand was charged to MWC BG for performing failure analysis.
