## **QUESTION 3**

In response to DRA-183-DFB, Question 6a, PG&E states: "Labor charges for Assistant Corporate Secretary and Senior Corporate Analyst of one-half hour per week for support of 14 non-utility subsidiaries equates to 26 hours per year." How did PG&E determine that two employees spent "half hour per week"? Provide the supporting documentation that supports allocation of time.

## ANSWER 3

We met with the Assistant Corporate Secretary, who is responsible for the corporate governance of the 14 non-utility subsidiaries, and the Senior Corporate Analyst, who is responsible for the compliance for these subsidiaries, to discuss the time spent performing these functions. They estimated that on average, the amount of time they spend on work related to the non-utility subsidiaries is no more than one-half hour a week (combined). They based their estimates on their prior experience performing this work.
