- b. Provide the effective date of the regulation and a copy of the final regulation. Please highlight the text that PG&E based its forecast on.
- c. If the regulation is not final, when does PG&E anticipate a final regulation?

This applies to all large off-road spark ignition engines effective January 1, 2007. Please find the text from page 3-377 below which highlights the effective date.

Article 4.5. Off-Road Large Spark-Ignition Engines § 2430. Applicability.

(a) (1) This article applies to large off-road spark-ignition engines 25 horsepower and greater produced on or after January 1, 2001 and all equipment and vehicles produced on or after January 1, 2001 that use such engines. **Beginning January 1, 2007, this**

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article applies to large off-road spark-ignition engines above 19 kilowatt (kW) and all equipment and vehicles that use such engines.

ANSWER 2C

This is the final regulation.
