- a. Please provide a copy of the final regulation and the effective date. Please highlight the text that affects PG&E's forecast.
- b. Please describe whether the final regulation changes any of PG&E's testimony and forecast regarding the In-Use Off-Road Diesel Regulation.
- c. If the regulation is not final, when does PG&E anticipate a final regulation?
