Please provide the following information no later than **COB, May 13, 2010**. This request includes basic system and interconnection data on all Combined Heat and Power (CHP) facilities, including Qualifying Facility (QF) Cogeneration, exporting CHP that is not Qualifying Facility Cogeneration, and non-exporting CHP facilities, in each utility territory. This data will be used by Energy Division staff to support analysis of current and potential CHP capacity pursuant to state mandates.

Attached is a spreadsheet which contains all the fields to be completed for this request. The data provided should reflect information on all CHP facilities interconnected in your territory. Specifically, it should reflect:

Facility Information

- Facility Identification Number: Please provide a unique identifying number for each facility listed. This number may be an interconnection ID or other identifier that is unique to the facility.
- Facility Name: Please provide the name of the facility or project.

Location

- Please provide the city, county and zip code for each facility.

CHP System Information

- Technology (Prime Mover): Please list the technology used for the CHP system. For example: reciprocating engine, combustion turbine, microturbine, steam turbine, fuel cell, etc.
- Fuel: Please indicate the primary fuel type used in the CHP system. For example: natural gas, propane, biogas, landfill gas, exhaust heat, coal, steam, etc.
- Capacity: Please indicate the Nameplate capacity of the CHP system expressed in kW.
- Interconnection Type: Please indicate the interconnection procedure used to interconnect the system. For example: Rule 21, SGIP distribution, SGIP transmission, LGIP, etc.

- Interconnection Status: Please indicate the current interconnection status of the system. For example: operational, application pending, terminated/withdrawn, etc.
- Date Online: Please indicate what date the facility came online or is expected to come online.
- Date Terminated/Withdrawn (if applicable): Please indicate the date the facility was terminated or withdrawn.
- QF: Please indicate if the facility is Qualifying Facility (QF) Cogeneration (Y/N).
- Electricity Export: Please indicate if the facility is exporting electricity to the grid (Y/N).
- NAISC/SIC: Please provide the facility's North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code and/or Standard Industrial Classification (SIC) code.
