Jeanne, Simon, Athena, and Shilpa:

As you may have heard, the ED denied our Advice Letter on program issues today, without prejudice, instead instructing us to file a PFM to address these issues. I understand Don spoke with Jeanne this afternoon and they agreed to a call early next week to discuss next steps and how to approach the PFM. Please indicate your availability for this call early next week, perhaps Monday or Tuesday. We will follow up with further information. Thanks!

Background

Issues included in the AL were:

- Adopt the budget definitions and cost categories for the 2010-2012 cycle;
- Give SCE authority to execute all contracts for 2010-2012 programs with third party implementers and local government partners as early as January 1, 2012;
- Give SCE authority to report any program funding modifications, including cancellations, resulting from contract negotiations through current Commission reporting requirements;
- Clarify that the California Advanced Homes Program's \$1,000 bonus should be offered to single family units only;
- Clarify benchmarking requirements
- Clarify the eligibility requirements for SCE's EE On-Bill Financing subprogram.
