## RE: Notification of Rejection of Advice Letter (AL) 2417-E and Need for Petition for Modification to Decision (D). 09-09-047

Dear Mr. Jazayeri:

Recently, in the course of internal consultation in crafting a Resolution for Advice Letter (AL) 2417-E, filed on December 14, 2009, Energy Division staff has learned from our legal counsel that the topics raised for clarification in AL 2417-E do not fit the criteria for matters appropriate to advice letters, as set forth in General Order 96-B, Section 5.1. AL 2417-E asks for six clarifications related to D.09-09-047, and requests relief regarding SCE interpretations of the decision in many of these areas. We now understand that the issues raised in the advice letter are matters appropriate to more formal proceedings, seeking further guidance from the Commission, as set forth in General Order 96-B, Section 5.2.

Therefore, we reject AL 2417-E, without prejudice, pursuant to General Order 96-B, Sections 5.1 and 5.2. A Petition for Modification of D.09-09-047 is the appropriate procedure to address the clarifications sought in the advice letter. Petitions for Modification shall be submitted pursuant to Rule 16.4 of the Rules and Practice and Procedures. We regret the delay between initially suspending the Advice Letter and now realizing that we need to reject it.
