I have received two procedural inquiries from parties in this proceeding and will resolve them here.

1. I received a request from counsel for Group Petitioners to extend the deadline for filing a response to the Joint Petition For

Modification of D. 09-04-010 from May 17 to May 24, 2010 Based on the email service of the Joint Petition I received on April 15, service was made to the service list for the proceeding, including counsel for Group Petitioners. However, since there were apparently some minor changes made to the Joint Petition in the corrected filing made on April 20 (effective date April 15), I hereby extend the date by which a party may file a response to the Joint Petition to May 20, 2010, pursuant to Rule 16.4(f).

2. In response to TURN's inquiry about my preferred timing for Request(s) for Intervenor Compensation, I have no preference as to whether it is made in one or more parts and refer to Rule 17.3 which provides some latitude but requires that a Request be filed no later than 60 days after the issuance of the decision closing the proceeding.
