ALJ Wong:

I just wanted to let you know that PG&E intends to file within the next couple of days a Motion to Amend the Procedural Schedule in PG&E's Gas Transmission and Storage (GT&S) Rate Case (A.09-09-013), to extend the dates in the procedural schedule by approximately 90 days. The parties have made significant progress on settlement negotiations over the last several months, and would like to continue settlement negotiations, rather than divert resources to drafting testimony, which is currently due May 21. PG&E will also ask for expedited treatment on the motion. The motion will be supported by most of the active parties in the case. I wanted to run the following proposed dates by you first, to see if you have any conflicts:

August 20, 2010 Intervenor Testimony
September 13, 2010 Concurrent Rebuttal Testimony
September 20-October 1, 2010 Evidentiary Hearings
October 25, 2010 Opening Briefs
November 8, 2010 Reply Briefs
February 7, 2011 Proposed Decision Issued
February 28, 2011 Comments on PD
March 7, 2011 Reply Comments on PD
March-April 2011 Final Decision Issued

A few parties have indicated that they have proposed hearings beginning on September 27 for the SoCalGas FAR Update proceeding. The proposed hearing dates above would conflict with that proposal. If you are inclined to schedule the SoCalGas FAR Update hearings beginning September 27, we will most likely move the dates proposed above by 1 week to avoid the conflict. Please let me know your preference. Thanks.
