I noticed this AL lists the wrong CREZ:

http://www.pge.com/notes/rates/tariffs/tm2/pdf/ELEC_3681-E.pdf. I've noticed PG&E's advice letter filings routinely contain errors like this. I'm assuming a Solano project would be in a Solano CREZ. This one is listed in a CREZ in Shasta. This seems like it should be pretty obviously wrong, so I'm guessing it's a process issue. Can you talk to the right people and see how this sort of error can be prevented? I (and the public) would greatly appreciate it.
