ADVICE LETTER 1956-G (U 902-G)

PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

SUBJECT: WITHDRAWAL OF SCHEDULE G-FIG AND FORM 122-1003 - FIBER OPTIC CABLE IN GAS PIPELINES

San Diego Gas and Electric Company (SDG&E) hereby submits for filing with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) revisions to its tariff schedules, applicable throughout its service territory, as shown on Attachment A.

PURPOSE

This filing requests Commission approval to withdraw Schedule G-FIG, Fiber Optic Cable in Gas Pipelines and Form 122-1003, Contract for Fiber Optic Cable in Gas Pipeline Services, for the reasons stated below.

BACKGROUND

Decision (D.) 03-10-017 authorized SDG&E to establish this new service allowing telecommunications and cable TV companies to place fiber optic cable in SDG&E's active gas pipelines. SDG&E filed Advice No. (AL) 1408-G on October 14, 2003 complying with D.03-10-017 which was approved and made effective on November 23, 2003. During the first three (3) years of the program, no customers participated in SDG&E's G-FIG service. In order to make the service more attractive, on August 8, 2006, SDG&E filed AL 1630-G to eliminate the Monthly Customer Charge and replace it by an annual charge per customer and per mile and a one-time charge, per project and per mile. In addition, SDG&E proposed the addition of an incremental O&M charge for ongoing work performed by the utility on pipelines with optical fiber installations that is not recovered by the new annual and one time charges. During the next three (3) years of the program, there was no demand for service under the G-FIG tariff.

SDG&E has not executed any contracts for fiber optic cable (FIG) service since the establishment of the service in 2003. SDG&E has no FIG customers and has not received any FIG revenues to date. SDG&E has not received any substantial inquires about FIG service and does not foresee future demand for FIG service.

With this filing, SDG&E withdraws Schedule G-FIG, Fiber Optic Cable in Gas Pipelines and Form 122-1003, Contract for Fiber Optic Cable in Gas Pipeline Services and it is herein removed from the tariff book as shown in the Table of Contents for Rate Schedules as shown on Attachment A.

PROTEST

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the California Public Utilities Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received by June 24, 2010, twenty days from the date filed. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
