Subject: An Ackerman-Deal Production: A Day in the Napa Valley on Friday, July 15

NARUC is holding its summer conference in Sacramento on July 17 through July 19. I have spoken to a few people that wanted to see the wine country while in the area. Okay with me. The Mattster and I cooked up an idea to develop a self-made tour of the wine country on Friday, June 15. It depends on whether we can get about 20 people to commit to the event.

My thought would be to meet just south of Napa, near the intersection of Hwys. 12 and 29; that makes it equidistance from both San Francisco and Sacramento. It's a no-host deal, and my quick estimate of the per person cost is \$150 for the bus, and three wine tours including food and drink at one of the wineries. What ever the cost turns out to be, we'll split it on a pro rata basis. We can also have an option to dine in Yountville either as a group, or as an option for those who want to after the tour.
