Today, Jonathan Arnold came out with a brief report on the Manzana schedule and the GRC hearings. On Manzana, he points out intervenor opposition related to costs and environmental concerns. Arnold concludes by saying, "*The case could provide further insight into the CPUC's view of utility-owned renewables (beyond the utilities' solar PV projects).*" This report supports what we have seen - that analysts are tracking Manzana and the GRC closely and view them as the largest upcoming cases for the rest of the year.
