QUESTION 4

Please describe the procedure by which every 20th entry was chosen in the above spreadsheet. What data file was used as the basis for choosing every 20th meal. How was the data file ordered, if the choice was by order? Was the choice by random number generation? What were the steps involved?

ANSWER 4

As indicated in PG&E's response to GRC2011-Ph-I_DR_DRA_260-Q01Supp02, the original response included a typographical error. The response should have referenced every **21st** entry instead of every **20th**.

The data was extracted from PG&E's Concur Central system, and sorted by the field "Line Item Date" (which indicates the date of the meal). Then, every 21st entry was selected (skipping 20 entries between selected entries). This selection of every 21st entry was the sampling approach that was agreed upon with TURN in response to their data requests on this subject.
