QUESTION 2

(Page 13 of Exhibit DRA-33 shows that these 700 employees must undergo training in year one of the HCP's implementation and it is PG&E's contention in this case that 2009 was the first year that PG&E started to comply with the HCP. See page 1368 of volume 13 of the transcripts.)

ANSWER 2

In 2009, approximately 2,150 employees who work within the geographic boundary of the San Joaquin Valley O&M HCP were provided training so that they would be aware of the permit requirements when performing work in the HCP area.
