Specifically, I requested:

1/ Accurate permitting information for the project, and

2/ Revised AMF worksheet with consistent use of TOD factors

Also, can you please explain the various PPA terms and conditions where PG&E would pay a proportion of the contract price. Feel free to edit the language below or provide a separate response that clearly defines the terms and condition.

PG&E will pay less than the contract price prior to the project being fully developed and if certain conditions are met. Specifically,

PG&E will pay 80% of the contract price for

all generation produced during the project's Initial Energy Delivery Date, defined as period between when initial capacity is installed and generating until greater than 12 MW are installed and operational;

PG&E will pay the contract price minus \$15/MWh for generation [define terms]; and

PG&E will pay 75% of the contract price for any deliveries that exceed 120% of the monthly expected generation.
