<http://eega2006.cpuc.ca.gov/DisplayAnnualReport.aspx?ID=6>. When looking at the 2009 Annual Excel Report (ID 3967), Tab "Table 8" lists the savings for Consumer Electronics. It is under line 7.

One thing to note, it is reported that the Business and Consumer Electronics Program had 28.93 GWh and 2.34 MW. The numbers we reported in the Governor's Environmental and Economic Leadership Award are higher, because they include all of the savings that came from sales through December 2009, but may not have been paid in 2009.

Don't hesitate to call me if you have trouble finding the data.

If you're interested, I'm happy to chat with you a bit about the program in general and give you some background on what PG&E has been doing in the electronics space and some of the impacts on the market we've seen.
