On Monday, an analysis will be released by M.J. Bradley and Associates (MJBA) and The Analysis Group that was conducted on behalf of the Clean Energy Group's

Clean Air Policy Initiative. PG&E, along with Calpine, Exelon, Constellation, Entergy, Public Service Enterprise Group, National Grid and NextEra Energy are all members of the Clean Energy Group's Clean Air Policy Initiative. The report is titled Ensuring a Clean, Modern Electric Generating Fleet while Maintaining Electric System Reliability. The report was prepared in response to EPA's upcoming regulations that primarily affect coal-fired power plants and the potential impact of these regulations on electric reliability. The report concludes that without threatening electric reliability, the industry is well-positioned to respond to the EPA's proposed road map provided that the EPA and other public and private actors take practical steps to plan for the implementation of these regulations. The report is intended to be a constructive way to engage with stakeholders and policymakers on the relevant policies. We expect the report will be well received by the environmental community, the Administration, Chairwoman Boxer (Senator Boxer chairs the Senate Environment and Public Works Committee), and Chairman Waxman (Congressman Waxman chairs the House Energy and Commerce Committee).

Attached, please find a copy of the press release that will be issued by MJBA and The Analysis Group. Following its release, the report authors will be scheduling meetings with the Administration, members of Congress, EPA and other stakeholders to discuss the findings.
