Mike;

Would appreciate your help on an issue Chip Stalica is dealing with.

This is an issue noticed by President Peevey and staff on a recent CPUC tour, and subsequently brought to Peter Darbee and Chris Johns attention.

We have two "local" issues at the Pit 1 diversion near Fall River Mills. We have struggled to deal with these with local enforcement over the years, I'd say less than successfully. We need to take concerted action to put an end to this.

First is graffiti on the dam. It takes about \$20k a shot to paint over it each time.

Second, but more important is a public safety issue - where kids get into the outfall, and tie on ropes to the structure to "wakeboard" in the flow.

We've been successful in resolving these issues when we've been able to get an arrest, get it prosecuted, and get it publicized. I think we've had trouble getting steps 1 and 2 accomplished.

Can you give us recommendations on security enhancements and some help with local enforcement and the DA?

I know Chip is already on this, but did want to assure it's on your radar screen given political sensitivities.

Thanks for your teams always expert and professional support.
