Subject: SB 722 - Oppose letter

We issued the attached oppose letter on SB 722 earlier today relating to a 33% RPS mandate. Our major concerns relate to cost implications because of the tight timeframes for achieving the renewable targets and the restricted resource mix that we have available to us. In our messaging we are noting the fact that we have supported previous RPS efforts including an effort last year that the Governor vetoed. However, this version of the bill in the last month of the session doesn't provide the tools necessary for success. Discussions continue with the author and others to try to get us to a position of support but we are not there yet.
