Thanks again for taking the time to meet with us yesterday on pumped storage. Here are the follow-ups to your questions from the meeting.

1. The US forest for the Mokelumne project is the El Dorado National Forrest.
2. The interconnection facility for a Mokelumne project will be the Bellota Substation.
3. CAES update - PG&E submitted the final contract to the DOE on May 24. The latest update from the DOE is to expect approval by the end of this month. Once approved, we expect Phase 1 activities (site selection, geologic verification, permit filing preparation, and plant engineering) to begin in Q3 2010.
