Yesterday evening, PG&E's Board of Directors convened and approved a plan to help the residents of San Bruno rebuild their community in the aftermath of last Thursday's tragic gas transmission pipeline rupture and explosion. We cannot emphasize strongly enough: we are committed to doing what is right and appropriate for the individuals and the community affected by this terrible incident.

Today, we will hold a press conference at noon to share details with the public about our plans to begin the long journey to restore this community, and to reinforce our dedication to the City of San Bruno and its residents, our customers. Employees will be provided with a dial-in number to listen to the press conference live.

Additionally, at approximately 1 p.m., we will host a company-wide meeting via teleconference to update our employees on these efforts. The call will include a question-and-answer segment.

Invitations from Internal Communications with details for both events are forthcoming. Please encourage your employees to participate.

As a reminder, National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) rules severely limit our ability to share details related to the investigation that is now under way.

Please reinforce to your teams that we are committed to determining the cause of the incident; ensuring the safety of our customers, our communities, and our employees; and to doing whatever is necessary to provide support and aid for those whose lives have been touched by this tragedy.
