Thank you for your attendance at the Zero Net Energy (ZNE) Webinar on September 1, 2010. We appreciate your participation and input into the ZNE effort, one of the Commission's four Big, Bold Strategies of the California Long Term Energy Efficiency Strategic Plan.

As part of its continuing effort to implement the Strategic Plan, the Commission directed Southern California Edison to hire a consultant, The Donald Vial Center on Labor, to perform a California Workforce Education and Training Needs Assessment (CWNA). The purpose of the CWNA is to analyze the workforce and training in energy efficiency and related industries and determine whether the current workforce and infrastructure is equipped to meet the goals of the Strategic Plan.

The research for the CWNA is proceeding and will be complete in November 2010. On December 8, 2010, the Commission will host an Energy Efficiency Workforce Summit in Berkeley, California to share the findings of the CWNA and the strategies to meet any gaps as proposed by the consultant.
