Just to keep you in the loop, Trina and I touched base with Cynthia Walker on Friday regarding the Oakley PTM and the GWF/Los Esteros advice letter. On the advice letter, she saw our response to the protest and DRA is going to be discussing next steps this week. On the PTM, similar to our conversation with Mike Florio, we indicated that we were open to working with DRA on the PTM to see if we could come up with solutions that may result in them supporting, or at least not opposing the PTM. Cynthia indicated that she would talk with people there and get back to us.
