Subject: Meeting with PG&E on Smart Grid deployment plan status and cyber-security

All:

I am writing to request a meeting between PUC staff and PG&E regarding the status of their Smart Grid deployment plan and a separate meeting to discuss PG&E's cyber-security plans and policies. As per SB 17, I also intend to invite staff from the CEC and CAISO to participate in this meeting; please let me know if you have any concerns with that.

The purpose of the deployment plan meeting is to get an understanding of PG&E's progress and concerns, if any, on creating a Smart Grid deployment plan as directed by the June 24 Commission decision and SB 17 in time for the July 1, 2011 deadline. We expect to hold a status meeting regularly leading up to July 1, 2011.

The purpose of the cyber-security meeting is gather information on the state of PG&E's cyber-security policy, plans and programs, and will likely be highly technical. This meeting, in addition to the upcoming outreach event with NIST, will help PUC staff plan accordingly for a future phase of the Smart Grid OIR proceeding that will address grid and customer cyber-security policies and guidelines.

I propose to have these meetings sometime during the first two weeks of October. If that does not work, I am open to alternate dates.
