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Subject: EMF/RF studies?

Gentlemen: I am getting frustrated with the "EMF/RF issue", which seems to come back again and again (I am also seeing signs of it starting to spread to LA and SD areas). Is anyone aware of ANY studies that include data, let's say, "ambient" levels of RF emissions (presumably at certain frequencies of interest) at random points in the field (different parts of a house/apt. complex, in the neighborhood, street, parks, etc.) with the RF Mesh/meters deployed and with NO deployment in the area? If not, how hard would it be to do this. In such a study, presumably the data would need to be collected over some interval to determine the cumulative, as well as instantaneous, exposure levels. It should be a study NOT funded by IOUs. Perhaps a university could be persuaded to undertake such a study? I am at the point of reaching out to some, starting with UCLA, myself. Aloke
