Dear Ms. Fitch:

In accordance with Commission Decision ("D.") 06-10-050 and the Assigned Commissioner's Ruling with Final Document Addressing Process Issues Relative to RPS Compliance Reports, issued November 20, 2008 in R.08-08-009 ("ACR"), Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") hereby re-forwards to the Energy Division and the service list its August 2, 2010 Renewable Portfolio Standard ("RPS") Compliance Report.

I. BACKGROUND

Each RPS-obligated load serving entity is required to file an updated RPS compliance report within 30 days after the California Energy Commission ("CEC") issues its RPS Verification Report.¹ The ACR clarified that the 30-day reporting period would commence with the CEC's issuance of a "notice of availability" of its Verification Report. On August 18, 2010, the CEC issued a Notice of Availability concerning its final Renewable Portfolio Standard 2006 Procurement Verification Report ("CEC Verification Report"), which the CEC adopted at its July 28, 2010 Business Meeting. The ACR further provided that the Verified RPS Compliance report is to be filed with the Energy Division and served on the R.08-08-009 service list.² The verified Compliance report is not to be filed with the docket office. Accordingly, PG&E's Verified RPS Compliance Report must be filed with the Energy Division on or before September 17, 2010.

In an August 19, 2010 e-mail to the R.08-08-009 service list, the Commission's Energy Division stated that "[i]f the verified report contains the same data as the August 2, 2010 filings, entities may re-forward the August 2, 2010 filing to Energy Division and the service list by September 17, 2010 with a short explanation that the data contained in the August 2, 2010 filing is the same as the data verified by the CEC."

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II. THE CALIFORNIA ENERGY COMMISSION'S FINDINGS

The CEC Verification Report provides the CEC's findings on the amount of renewable energy procured by PG&E and other selected retail sellers of electricity. The eligible procurement amounts reported by the CEC for PG&E in its Verification Report are the same amounts claimed by PG&E in its final CEC-RPS-Track forms filed with the CEC for each of the subject years: 2001, 2003 through 2006.

III. PG&E'S AUGUST 2, 2010 RPS COMPLIANCE REPORT CONTAINS THE SAME DATA AS THE CEC VERIFICATION REPORT

The RPS procurement data for 2001, 2003 through 2006 contained in PG&E's August 2, 2010 RPS Compliance Report are the same as the procurement data verified by the CEC in its Verification Report. Accordingly, pursuant to the Energy Division's direction, PG&E is re-forwarding its August 2, 2010 RPS Compliance Report to the Energy Division and R.08-08-009 service list.


IV. COMMENTS AND MOTION SCHEDULE
