At the conclusion of a meeting I was having with Assemblymember Bill Monning today, he gave me a heads up about an op-ed he has submitted and that will run in the Santa Cruz Sentinel on Sunday morning regarding SmartMeters. Monning met with the CPUC last week and was happy to hear from them that we are on the same page regarding discussions related to exploring potential options for those customers who don't want a wireless SmartMeter installed.

In the op-ed, he plans to outline what his office has done related to this issue, including having discussions with both PG&E and the CPUC. He further let me know that in his article he will say that he hasn't been convinced that there are health risks associated with SmartMeters, however, he knows that some of his constituents are concerned and that he will continue to follow and be involved in the issue.
