RE: Submittal of California Solar Initiative Semi-Annual Expense Reports

Dear Mr. Cherry:

This is in response to your letter dated December 9, 2010, in which you requested, on behalf of Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), Southern California Edison Company, and the California Center for Sustainable Energy (collectively, the California Solar Initiative (CSI) Program Administrators (PAs)), an extension of time to comply with Ordering Paragraph (OP) 1 of Decision (D.) 07-05-047. Your request was made pursuant to Rule 16.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.

Your letter states that OP 1 and item 7 of Appendix A of D.07-05-047 require the PAs to submit their Semi-Annual Expense Reports by January 15 and July 15 of each year. The letter further states that the Energy Division has requested that these reports also include yearly totals for all program elements that make up the CSI program, including the Multi-family Affordable Solar Housing program, the virtual net energy metering billing development, the Research, Development and Demonstration program, and any incidental expenses associated with the administration of the Single-family Affordable Solar housing program. The letter states that some of the accounting data are not available until the second week of the month. Thus, the letter requests a permanent 16-day extension to gather all the necessary accounting data for the above reports.

I grant a one time 16-day extension for 2011. Given that PAs will need to collect data through the middle of the month for their reports, a 16-day extension is reasonable. The PAs' Semi-Annual Expense Reports will be due on January 31 and July 31 of 2011. A request for a permanent extension of these dates is, in effect, a request to modify D.07-05-047. Therefore, to receive a permanent extension, the PAs may file a petition to 440089

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modify D.07-05-047 pursuant to Rule 16.4 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure

PG&E shall inform all of the parties in Rulemaking 10-05-004 of the extension granted herein and shall state in the opening paragraph of the document that the Executive Director has authorized the extension. All other requirements of D.07-05-049 continue to apply.
