Hi Timothy,

Sorry to miss you at the CCCYO Board meeting yesterday. I heard you had to be out of town and I am sure things are very busy for you. I have attached two pictures of the valve over the transmission pipelines in our yard just for your information. This valve just controls an 1 1/4" pipe off transmission pipeline #132 to a neighboring facility.

Thank you for the referral into PGE. They have been very responsive and have already cleared a great amount of branches, fallen trees and brush over the pipelines in and behind our yard to improve emergency access. They have more information they are promising me and I expect that soon. I must say this has been a learning experience. Ultimately since we have these two very old major transmission lines #109 and #132 in our yard, I am not sure one can feel reasonably comfortable about living so close to them without PGE having the capability of using the most modern and technologically advanced monitoring and testing techniques and having remote automated control of these two transmission pipelines.
