**NOTICE OF EX PARTE COMMUNICATION OF
THE DIVISION OF RATEPAYER ADVOCATES**

Pursuant to Rules 8.2, 8.3 and 8.5 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) gives notice of the following ex parte communication in this proceeding. At 11:15 a.m. on December 9, 2010, in the San Francisco offices of the CPUC, Cheryl Cox, DRA Policy Advisor and Diana Lee, staff attorney in the Legal Division, met with Matthew Tisdale, advisor to Commissioner Dian Grueneich. DRA initiated the communication, which was oral.

DRA explained that proposed reforms to the energy efficiency incentive mechanism that are currently under consideration in Rulemaking (R.) 09-01-019 must incorporate accurate *ex ante* energy savings values that have been reviewed and verified by the Energy Division, or the savings from the 2010-2012 portfolios will be overstated. DRA noted that the amount of additional time needed to ensure that verified *ex ante* values were used was justified by the fact that the results would be more accurate.
