Some of your recent Advice Letters related to the creation of a new affiliate were related to the solar industry. Please reserve the Advice Letters with additional service as noted below.

AL 3141-G/3708-E (filed July 23, 2010) has been suspended. This AL should be re-served on R. 10-05-004. AL 3170-G/3763-E (filed . November 22, 2010) has just been filed. This AL can be re-served on R. 10-05-004. AL 3091-G/3616-E (filed February 11, 2010) has been rejected. We understand there is a supplement on that possibly being prepared.
